European Championship will start just in Warsaw on Warsaw National Stadium.



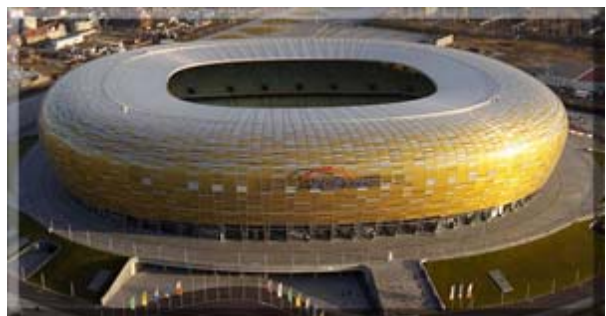
